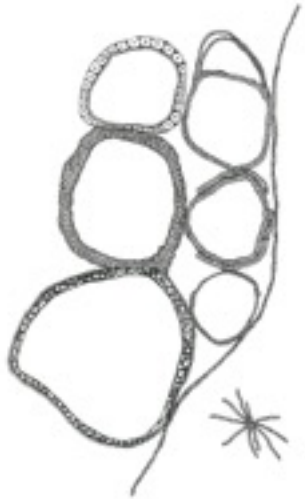

What is Leisure Mountain?

What objects encapsulate Leisure Mountain?
